

Your evacuation can save lives!

During disasters, **most people evacuate because others around them are too.**

Be the first one to take action and start evacuation.

Prepare in advance! Actions like habitually talking to neighbors will help lead to **prompt evacuation.**

Think of multiple evacuation shelters, such as relatives' or acquaintances houses in safe areas. Don't be limited to your city's or town's official evacuation sites.

Alert Level 3

(Evacuate elderly and others requiring assistance)

Evacuate the elderly and others who require additional time. Everyone else prepare to evacuate.

Alert Level 4

(Everyone evacuate)

Everyone in dangerous locations must evacuate. Take quick action, such as evacuating during the daytime, etc.

Alert Level 5 means that the disaster is currently underway.

Be the first one to take action and start evacuation.

What to do and when? **3 actions to save lives from landslides.**

#1

Know the risk level of **your home**.

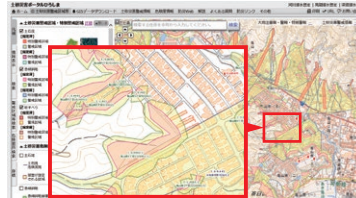

The areas specified in that region have the threat of landslides. Think ahead and make evacuation preparations.

Point
#2

On rainy days, continuously check for new information.

Check "landslide disaster hazard level information" ("どしゃさいがいきけんどうじょうほう") through NHK data broadcasts.

When there is heavy rain over a short period or when it rains for a long time, check landslide disaster hazard level information. ("どしゃさいがいきけんどうじょうほう").

You can check through the NHK General TV's "d" button



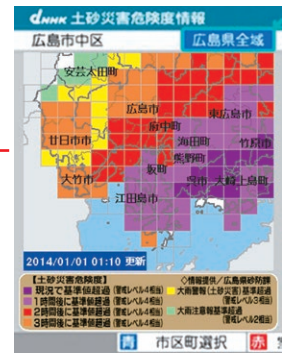
Instructions

- Go to the NHK General TV channel, and press the "d" (data broadcast) on the remote control.
- Choose (防災 [Disaster management] / 生活情報 [Lifestyle information])
- Choose (土砂災害危険度情報 [どしゃさいがいきけんどうじょうほう, Landslide disaster hazard level information])



Based on the postal code registered on your TV, your local landslide disaster hazard level information will be displayed.

Point
#3

When evacuating, take action while communicating with each other. Be the first one to speak up.

Protect yourself from danger through quick action and cooperation.

Important!

Evacuate while there is still daylight.

Communicate with your family and neighbors while evacuating.

If it is impossible to go outside, evacuate to a place above the 2nd floor and away from cliffs.
